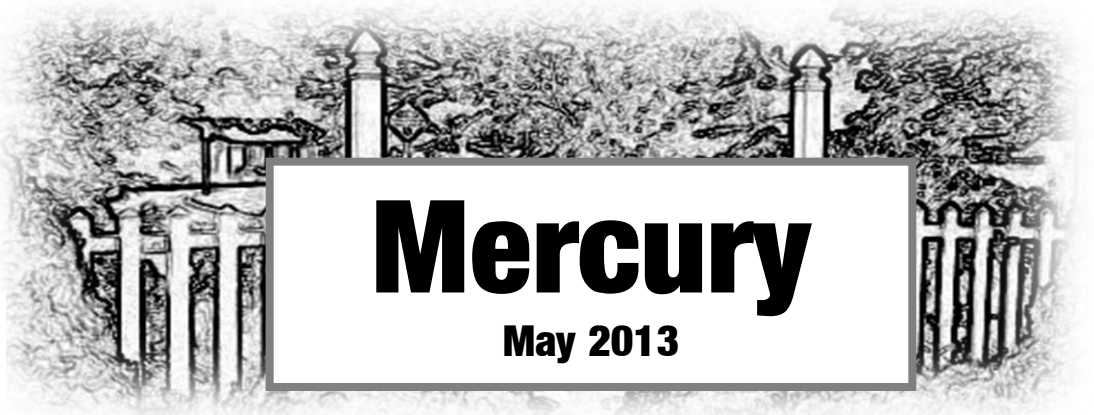

### **Airing Complaints About TV Ads**

Still scrambling to turn down the volume on TV commercials? Under the new Commercial Advertisement Loudness Mitigation Act (CALM), ads can't be louder on average than the programs they accompany.

If you have a gripe, you can file a complaint with the FCC. You can also contact the TV station, pay-TV provider, programming network or advertiser. Be sure to include specifics, name of advertiser, date, time and network. To file online, go to [fcc.gov/complaints](http://fcc.gov/complaints) and click "Broadcast, Cable, and Satellite Issues" then "Loud Commercials." You can also call 888-225-5322 toll free.
